



## 2019 Global Scope program packages

### 4-week option on a tourist visa

Minimum IELTS 5.5 / TOEFL PBT 520 / TOEFL ITP 500

3 program choices:

- Arrive Sydney 28 January (NB Monday Australia Day public holiday) Depart Sydney 23 February 2019 (1-week of English preparation for business project + 3-week Business Projects program)
- Arrive Sydney 23 June Depart Sydney 20 July 2019 (as above)
- Arrive Sydney 10 November Depart Sydney 7 December 2019 (as above)

Includes 4 weeks of homestay, airport transfers and free campus Wi-Fi during training at WSU, Business Projects program.

**Cost: AU\$3,700 per person\***

\*Minimum of 10 students required to run this program. (For a minimum of 5 students the price would be AU\$4,420 each.)

### 13-week option on a tourist visa

Minimum IELTS 5.0 / TOEFL PBT 520 / TOEFL ITP 500

1 program choice:

- Arrive Sydney 22 April (NB Monday public holiday for Easter) Depart Sydney 20 July (10-week block of English for Academic Purposes + 3-week Business Projects program 1-19 July)

Includes 13 weeks of homestay, airport transfers, free campus Wi-Fi during training at WSU, Business Projects program.

**Cost: AU\$9,740 per person**

### 12-week option on a tourist visa

Minimum IELTS 5.0 / TOEFL PBT 520 / TOEFL ITP 500

1 program choice:

- Arrive Sydney 15 September Depart Sydney 7 December (9-week block of English for Academic Purposes + 3-week Business Projects program 18 Nov – 6 Dec)

Includes 12 weeks of homestay, airport transfers, free campus Wi-Fi during training at WSU, Business Projects program.

**Cost: AU\$9,010 per person**



## Global Scope Outcomes

- **90%** completion rate (voluntary, co-curricular program)
- 90% of students and 80% of clients & mentors would **recommend participation** to a friend or colleague
